• Conference Champions for 2019-2020 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2018-2019 Season: SEC, AAC, Big 12, ACC, PAC-12, Big Ten
 • Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
 • Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '19-'20 Reg. Season + '19-'20 Bowl = '19-'20 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '19-'20 Reg. Season - 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '19-'20 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (LSU, Memphis, Oklahoma, Clemson, Oregon, Ohio State) + 2 Games (GA, FL, Baylor, Wisconsin)
