

2010-2011 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2010-2011 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2009-2010 Season: SEC, Big Ten, ACC, PAC-10, Big East, Mountain West
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '10-'11 Reg. Season + '10-'11 Bowl = '10-'11 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '10-'11 Reg. Season - 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '10-'11 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (Auburn, CT, Wisconsin, TCU, Oregon, VA Tech) + 2 Games (Stanford, Arkansas, Ohio State, Oklahoma)
