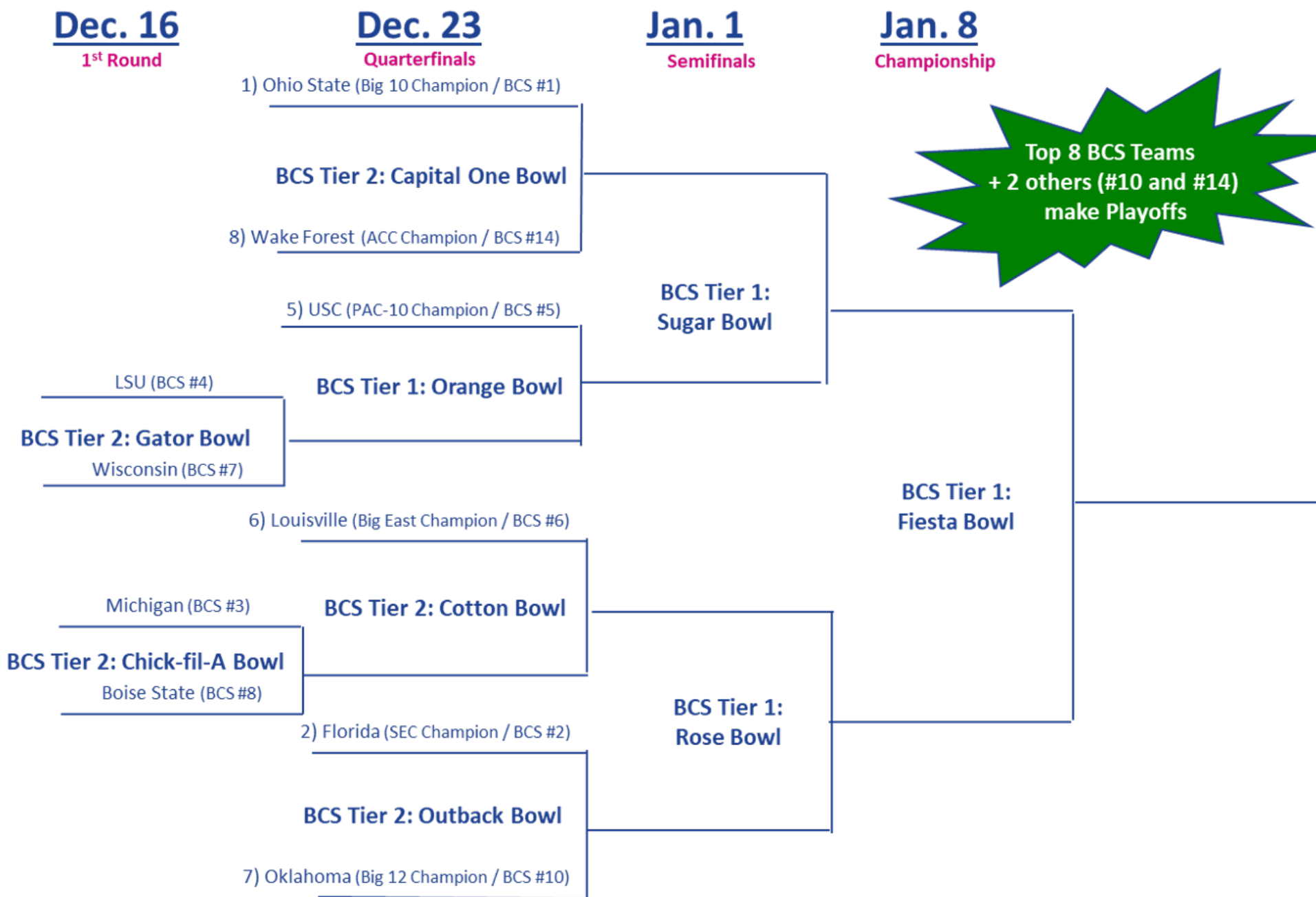


2006-2007 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2006-2007 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2005-2006 Season: SEC, Big 10, PAC-10, ACC, Big 12, Big East
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '06-'07 Reg. Season + '06-'07 Bowl = '06-'07 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '06-'07 Reg. Season - 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '06-'07 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (Ohio State, Wake Forest, Louisville, USC, FL, OU) + 2 Games (Michigan, Boise State, Wisconsin, LSU)
