2005-2006 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2005-2006 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2004-2005 Season: SEC, Big 12, PAC-10, ACC, Big 10, Mountain West
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '05-'06 Reg. Season + '05-'06 Bowl = '05-'06 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '05-'06 Reg. Season 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '05-'06 Playoff Total): +1 Games (USC, FL State, GA, Texas, TCU, Penn State) +2 Games (Ohio State, Miami, Oregon, Notre Dame)
