

# 2007-2008 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2007-2008 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2006-2007 Season: SEC, Big 12, ACC, Big Ten, PAC-10, Big East
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '07-'08 Reg. Season + '07-'08 Bowl = '07-'08 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '07-'08 Reg. Season - 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '07-'08 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (LSU, USC, VA Tech, OU, WV, Ohio State) + 2 Games (Kansas, Hawaii, Missouri, Georgia)
