2004-2005 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2004-2005 scenario come from initial BCS Conferences: PAC-10, Big East, ACC, SEC, Big 12, Big Ten
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '04-'05 Reg. Season + '04-'05 Bowl = '04-'05 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '04-'05 Reg. Season 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '04-'05 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (USC, Pitt, VA Tech, Auburn, OU, Iowa) + 2 Games (Texas, GA, CA, Utah)
