

2011-2012 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2011-2012 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2010-2011 Season: SEC, Big Ten, Big 12, PAC-10, WAC, Mountain West
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '11-'12 Reg. Season + '11-'12 Bowl = '11-'12 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '11-'12 Reg. Season - 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '11-'12 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (LSU, LA Tech, Oregon, TCU, Oklahoma State, Wisconsin) + 2 Games (Stanford, Arkansas, Alabama, Boise State)
