

2009-2010 College Football Playoff System



- Conference Champions for 2009-2010 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2008-2009 Season: SEC, Big Ten, Big 12, PAC-10, Big East, Mountain West
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '09-'10 Reg. Season + '09-'10 Bowl = '09-'10 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '09-'10 Reg. Season - 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '09-'10 Playoff Total): + 1 Games (Alabama, TX, TCU, Oregon, Ohio State, GA Tech, Cincinnati) + 2 Games (GA, Boise State, Iowa, FL)
