- Conference Champions for 2008-2009 scenario come from Top 6 Conferences in 2007-2008 Season: SEC, Big 12, ACC, Big Ten, PAC-10, Big East
- Pre-Season Classics are not allowed to invite Playoff System participants to play in pre-season classics in the following year and all colleges have to reduce the # of non-conference games by 1 to counter the possible increase in games for schools who make it to the Playoffs
- Net +/- games played under proposed playoff system versus existing bowl system (Actual '08-'09 Reg. Season + '08-'09 Bowl = '08-'09 Actual Total VERSUS Actual '08-'09 Reg. Season 1 non-conference game + # of playoff games to win championship in playoff system = '08-'09 Playoff Total): +1 Games (Cincinnati, FL, USC, Penn St, VA Tech, OU) +2 Games (Utah, AL, TTU, Texas)
